

Blissen Privacy Policy

Effective Date of Current Policy: April 30, 2020

1. PURPOSE

Welcome to our Privacy Policy! Blissen LLC, together with our affiliates ("Blissen", "we", or "us") have adopted this Privacy Policy to let you know how we treat the information that we collect from you online and offline, the kinds of information we may collect, how that information is used, with whom we share it and how you can opt-out of a use or correct or change such information. This Privacy Policy supplements and forms a part of the Blissen Terms of Use (the "Terms"). Capitalized terms not defined in Section 13 or otherwise in this Privacy Policy have the meaning given to them in the Terms.

2. SCOPE

This Privacy Policy applies to Personal Information that is Processed by Blissen in the course of our business, including via the Blissen Site and through our forums, social media accounts, and other online or offline offerings (together with any and all future online and offline offerings operated by or on behalf of Blissen, the "Services"). All individuals whose responsibilities include the Processing of Personal Information on behalf of Blissen are expected to protect that data by adherence to this Privacy Policy.

Residents of California should be aware that California law affords them certain rights regarding their Personal Information. Residents of California should review the California Privacy Notice that supplements and forms a part of this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy does not apply to Personal Information of Blissen employees and guides processed in the employment context, but employees and guides who elect to use the Services will be treated as users in accordance with this Privacy Policy with respect to Personal Information Processed as users of our Service.

3. TRANSPARENCY/NOTICE—TYPES OF PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW WE USE IT

The types of Personal Information we may collect (directly from you or from third party sources) and our privacy practices depend on the nature of the relationship you have with Blissen and the requirements of applicable law. Some of the ways that Blissen may collect Personal Information include:

You may provide Personal Information directly to Blissen through interacting with the Services (including when you use our online platform or via our subscription services), participating in surveys, and during promotions or sweepstakes.

As you navigate the Services, certain passive information may also be collected about your visit, including through cookies and similar technologies as described below.

It is our goal to collect only that information which is relevant for the purposes of Processing. Below are the ways we collect Personal Information and how we use it.

3.1 TYPES OF PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Blissen collects Personal Information from its current, prospective, and former customers, members, users, visitors, and guests (collectively "Individuals").

Information You Provide Directly to Us. When you use the Services, contact us directly, or engage in certain activities, such as registering for an account with Blissen, purchasing Blissen products or Services from us, subscribing to our site, registering to our site, viewing recorded content, or attending live events, we may ask you to provide some or all of the following types of information

Purchases. When you choose to purchase Blissen products or Services from us including membership subscription, apparel, or other services offered through any device, we may collect information from you including Personal Information, such as your name, email address, mailing address, phone number, birthday, payment information, such as a credit card number and/or other related information that may be required from you to complete your purchase (such as payment information, "Financial Information"). Unless we tell you otherwise at the time of your purchase or application for financing, your Financial Information is Processed by our third party processors and we do not collect, store or maintain your Financial Information. For more information on how your information is shared in these instances, please see Section 3.5 ("Third-Party Payment Processing") below. We will also collect a username and password in connection with any account created via the Services.

Public User Profiles. When you use the Blissen platform or subscribe to Blissen, you will be given the opportunity to create a "User Profile" and when you do so we may ask you to provide information about yourself such as a username, email address, location, birthday, phone number and image or avatar. Only your name, birthday, email address and username are required to set up a User Profile; the rest of the information that you may provide is optional. Once your User Profile is created, anytime you log in to participate in a studio class in-person or via our subscription service, we will collect additional information regarding your viewing data, "feelings" input on the community check-in, and followers/following.

You acknowledge that your User Profile information may be personal to you, and by creating an account and providing such information through the use of our Services, you allow others, including Blissen, to identify you and therefore you may not be anonymous. Blissen User Profiles are set to private by default, which means that other registered Blissen users will also be able to view your User Profile if you choose so, including your name and forum posts (if you have posted anything), and those users can contact or follow you through the Services. You have the option to set your profile to "Private," which means that only members who you approve as followers can see your profile, and you can remove other users from your followers.

Voice and Likeness. Additionally, Blissen may contain a camera, microphone and voice control features. These features are in use only when activated by you, for example, to take a Blissen user profile photo or to join a live session.

Other User Information. Blissen may also collect other information from you as a result of your use of the Services, such as attendance history. We may associate this information with other Personal Information that you have provided in order to improve and provide the Services and as otherwise described in this Privacy Policy.

Communications with Us. We may collect Personal Information from you such as your email address, phone number or mailing address, when you choose to request information about our Services, participate in promotions, or loyalty programs that we may offer from time to time, request to receive member or technical support or otherwise communicate with us.

Surveys and Reviews. From time to time, we (or third parties acting on our behalf) may contact you to participate in research, surveys or beta testing or to provide reviews and testimonials. If you decide to participate, you may be asked to provide certain information, which may include Personal Information. All information collected from your participation in our research, surveys,

reviews or testimonial process, or beta testing is provided by you voluntarily. We may use such information to improve our products, our Site and/or Services, and in any manner consistent with this Privacy Policy.

Posting on the Blissen or Third Party Services. Blissen may offer publicly accessible forums, social media pages, content review pages, private messages, or member chat. You should be aware that, when you disclose information about yourself on Blissen's publicly accessible forums, social media pages, content review pages, private messages, or member chat, Blissen will collect the information you provide in such submissions, including any Personal Information. If you choose to submit content, including reviews, to any public area of the Services or on any public sites operated by third parties, such content will be considered "public" and will not be subject to the privacy protections provided in this Privacy Policy.

Registration for Sweepstakes or Contests. Occasionally, Blissen may run sweepstakes and contests. We ask those who enter sweepstakes or contests to provide contact information (e.g., a phone number or an email address). If you participate in a sweepstakes or contest, your contact information may be used to reach you about the sweepstakes or contest, and, to the extent permitted by law, for other promotional, marketing and business purposes. In compliance with the laws of your jurisdiction, as a participant you may have the opportunity to opt-out of any communications that are not related to awarding prizes.

Location Information. Based on your interaction with the Services, the type of device you use to access the Services, and your device's connectivity, we may collect location-based information including your Internet protocol (IP) address, GPS location, longitude/latitude, city, county, zip code and region, and your location. We may use this type of information to enhance your user experience and to better understand your interaction with our products and services. Unless you provide us with your consent to do otherwise, this information will only be used by us and our third party service providers to provide you with the Services you request or in an aggregated and anonymized format that does not identify you.

Automatic Data Collection. We may collect certain information automatically through our Services or other methods of web analysis, such as your IP address, cookie identifiers, mobile carrier, mobile advertising identifiers, MAC address, IMEI, Advertiser ID, and other device identifiers that are automatically assigned to your computer or device when you access the Internet, browser type and language, geo-location information, hardware type, operating system, Internet service provider, pages that you visit before and after using the Services, the date and time of your visit, the amount of time you spend on each page, information about the links you click and pages you view within the Services, and other actions taken through use of the Services such as preferences. For more information on Automatic Data Collection, please see Section 3.3.

Information Submitted Via Services. You agree that Blissen is free to use the content of any communications submitted by you via the Services, including any ideas, inventions, concepts, techniques, or know-how disclosed as part of that content, for any purpose including developing, manufacturing and/or marketing goods or Services. Blissen will not release your name or otherwise publicize the fact that you submitted materials or other information to us unless: (a) you grant us permission to do so; (b) we first send notice to you that the materials or other information you submit to a particular part of the Services will be published or otherwise used with your name on it; or (c) we are required to do so by law.

Information from Other Sources. We may receive information about you from other sources, including through third party services and organizations, to supplement information provided by you. For example, if you access our Services through a third party application, such as social media sites such as Facebook, we may collect information about you from that third party application that you have made public via your privacy settings. Information we collect through

social media accounts may include your name, your social media site user identification number, your user name, location, gender, birth date, email, profile picture and your social media contacts. This supplemental information allows us to verify information that you have provided to Blissen and to enhance our ability to provide you with information about our business, products and Services.

3.2 HOW Blissen USES YOUR INFORMATION

To Provide Products, Services or Information Requested. Blissen may use information about you to fulfill requests for products, Services or information, including information about potential or future services, including to:

Generally manage Individual information and accounts;

Respond to questions, comments, and other requests;

Provide access to certain areas, functionalities, and features of Blissen's Services;

Personalize your experience based on your usage data;

Communicate with you about logistical matters;

Provide services to you;

Review and contact you to answer requests for member support or technical support; and

Allow you to participate in for classes and events.

Administrative Purposes. Blissen may use Personal Information about you for its administrative purposes, including to:

Measure interest in Blissen's Services;

Develop new products and Services;

Ensure quality control;

Verify Individual identity;

Communicate about Individual accounts and activities on Blissen's Services and systems, and, in Blissen's discretion, changes to any Blissen policy;

Send emails or text messages to the email address or telephone number you provide to us to verify your account and for informational and operational purposes, such as account management, customer service, or system maintenance;

Process payment(s) for products or services purchased;

Process applications and transactions;

Prevent potentially prohibited or illegal activities;

Maintain and administer our Services; and

Enforce our Terms.

Marketing Blissen Products and Services. Blissen may use Personal Information to provide you with materials about offers, products and Services that may be of interest, including new content or services. Blissen may provide you with these materials by phone, postal mail, text or email, as permitted by applicable law. Such uses include:

To tailor content, advertisements and offers;

To notify you about offers, products and services that may be of interest to you or about which you have previously expressed an interest;

To provide Services to you;

For other purposes disclosed at the time that Individuals provide Personal Information; or

Otherwise with your consent. You may contact us at any time to opt-out of the use of your Personal Information for marketing purposes, as further described in Section 5 below.

You may contact us at any time to opt-out of the use of your Personal Information for marketing purposes, as further described in Section 6 below.

Research and Development. Blissen may use Personal Information to create non-identifiable information that we may use alone or in the aggregate with information obtained from other sources, in order to help us improve our existing products and Services or develop new

products and Services. From time to time, Blissen may perform research (online and offline) via surveys. We may engage third party service providers to conduct such surveys on our behalf. All survey responses are voluntary, and the information collected will be used for research and reporting purposes to help us better serve Individuals by learning more about their needs and the quality of the products and services we provide. The survey responses may be utilized to determine the effectiveness of our Services, various types of communications, advertising campaigns and/or promotional activities. If an Individual participates in a survey, the information given will be used along with that of other study participants. We may share anonymous Individual and aggregate data for research and analysis purposes.

Direct Mail, Email and Outbound Telemarketing. Individuals who provide us with Personal Information, or whose Personal Information we obtain from third parties, may, as permitted by law, receive periodic emails, newsletters, mailings, text messages or phone calls from us with information on Blissen's or our business partners' products and services or upcoming special offers/events that we believe may be of interest. We offer the option to decline these communications at no cost to the Individual by following the instructions in Section 5 below.

Services via Apps and other Devices. From time to time, Blissen may provide Services that are specifically designed to be compatible and used on third party devices, such as mobile phones and tablets. Blissen will collect certain information that your device sends when you use such Services, like a device identifier, user settings, location information, carrier and the operating system of your device. These versions of Blissen's Services may require that users log in with an account. In such cases, information about use of these versions of the Services may be associated with accounts. In addition, Blissen may enable you to download an application, widget or other tool that can be used on mobile, tablet or other devices. Some of these tools may store information on your devices. These tools may transmit Personal Information to Blissen to enable you to access accounts and to enable Blissen to track use of these tools. Some of these tools may enable users to export reports and other information from the tool. Blissen may use personal or non-identifiable information transmitted to Blissen to enhance these tools, to develop new tools, for quality improvement and as otherwise described in this Privacy Policy or in other notices Blissen provides.

Anonymous and Aggregated Information Use. Blissen may use Personal Information and other information about you to create anonymized and aggregated information, such as de-identified demographic information, de-identified location information, information about the computer or device from which you access Blissen's Services or other analyses we create. Anonymized and aggregated information is used for a variety of functions, including the measurement of visitors' interest in and use of various portions or features of the Services. Anonymized or aggregated information is not Personal Information, and Blissen may use such information in a number of ways, including research, internal analysis, analytics and any other legally permissible purposes. We may share this information within Blissen and with third parties for our or their purposes in an anonymized or aggregated form that is designed to prevent anyone from identifying you.

Sharing Content with Friends or Colleagues. Blissen's Services may offer various tools and functionalities. For example, Blissen may allow you to provide information about your friends through our referral services. Our referral services may allow you to forward or share certain content with a friend or colleague, such as an email inviting your friend to use our Services. Email addresses that you provide for a friend or colleague will be used to send your friend or colleague the content or link you request, but will not be used by Blissen for any other purpose.

Other Uses. Blissen may use Personal Information for which we have a legitimate interest, such as fraud protection or compliance with legal obligations, or any other purpose disclosed to you at the time you provide Personal Information or with your consent.

3.3 COOKIES, PIXEL TAGS/WEB BEACONS, ANALYTICS INFORMATION, AND INTEREST-BASED ADVERTISING

We, as well as third parties that provide content, advertising or other functionality on our Services, may use cookies, pixel tags, local storage and other technologies ("Technologies") to automatically collect information through the Services. We use Technologies that are essentially small data files placed on your computer, tablet, mobile phone or other devices that allow us to record certain pieces of information whenever you visit or interact with our website, services, applications, messaging and tools, and to recognize you across devices.

Cookies. Cookies are small text files placed in visitors' computer browsers to store their preferences. Most browsers allow you to block and delete cookies. However, if you do that, the Site may not work properly.

Pixel Tags/Web Beacons. A pixel tag (also known as a web beacon) is a piece of code embedded on the Site that collects information about users' engagement on that web page. The use of a pixel allows us to record, for example, that a user has visited a particular web page or clicked on a particular advertisement.

Social Media Widgets. The Site includes social media features such as links to Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube and LinkedIn (that might include widgets, such as, the share this button or other interactive mini-programs). These features may collect your IP address, which page you are visiting on the Site and may set a cookie to enable the feature to function properly. These social media features are either hosted by a third party or hosted directly on the Site. Your interactions with these features are governed by the privacy policy of the company providing it.

Analytics. We may also use Google Analytics and Google Analytics Demographics and Interest Reporting to collect information regarding visitor behavior and visitor demographics on some of our Services and to develop website content. This analytics data is not tied to any Personal Information. For more information about Google Analytics, please visit www.google.com/policies/privacy/partners/. You can opt-out of Google's collection and Processing of data generated by your use of the Services by going to <http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>. Our uses of such Technologies fall into the following general categories:

Operationally Necessary. We may use Technologies that are necessary to the operation of our Site, Services, applications, and tools. This includes Technologies that allow you access to our Site, Services, applications, and tools; that are required to identify irregular site behavior, prevent fraudulent activity and improve security; or that allow you to make use of functions such as shopping carts, saved search or similar functions;

Performance Related. We may use Technologies to assess the performance of our Site, applications, Services and tools, including as part of our analytic practices to help us understand how our visitors use our Site, determine if you have interacted with our messaging, determine whether you have viewed an item or link, or to improve our website content, applications, services or tools;

Functionality Related. We may use Technologies that allow us to offer you enhanced functionality when accessing or using our Sites, Services, applications or tools. This may include identifying you when you sign into our Sites or keeping track of your specified preferences, interests or past items viewed so that we may enhance the presentation of content on our Sites;

Advertising or Targeting Related. We may use first-party or third party cookies and web beacons to deliver content, including ads relevant to your interests, on our Sites or on third party sites.

This includes using technologies to understand the usefulness to you of the advertisements and content that has been delivered to you, such as whether you have clicked on an advertisement. If you would like to opt-out of the Technologies we employ on our Sites, Services, applications or tools, you may do so by blocking, deleting or disabling them as your browser or device permits. See Section 5 for additional opt-out options. Please note that blocking, deleting, or disabling these Technologies will affect the functionality of our Sites, Services, applications and tools, and may prevent you from being able to access certain features.

3.4 THIRD-PARTY WEBSITES, SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS, AND SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT KITS

The Service may contain links to other websites and other websites may reference or link to the Blissen Site or other Services. These other domains and websites are not controlled by us, and Blissen does not endorse or make any representations about third party websites or social media platforms. We encourage you to read the privacy policies of each and every website and application with which you interact. We do not endorse, screen or approve, and are not responsible for the privacy practices or content of such other websites or applications. Visiting other websites or applications is at your own risk.

Blissen's Services may include publicly accessible community forums, message boards, private messaging or video chat features. The Services may also contain links and interactive features with various social media or music platforms (e.g., widgets). If you already use these platforms, their cookies may be set on your device when using the Services. You should be aware that Personal Information that you voluntarily include and transmit online in a publicly accessible blog, video chat session, social media platform or otherwise online, or that you share in an open forum, may be viewed and used by others without any restrictions. We are unable to control such uses of your information when you interact with a third party platform, and by using such services you assume the risk that the Personal Information provided by you may be viewed and used by third parties for any number of purposes.

We use third party software development kits ("SDKs"), as part of the functionality of our Services. Your interactions with SDKs are governed by the privacy policy of the company providing the service.

3.5 THIRD-PARTY PAYMENT PROCESSING

When you make purchases through the Services, we Process your payments through a third party application: in the case of online via a Third-Party payment processor. In these instances, the third party application may collect certain Financial Information from you to Process a payment on behalf of Blissen, including your name, email address, address and other billing information in which case the use and storage of your Financial Information is governed by the third party app's terms, conditions and privacy policies. If you apply for or otherwise take part in a financing offer through one of our financing partners, you will be asked to provide information (which may include Financial Information) to that financing partner, either directly or through the Services. The use of that information by the financing partner will be subject to the financing partner's terms, conditions and privacy policies. Our treatment of any Financial Information that we may Process on your behalf, or that we receive from our financing partners or payment processors, is subject to this Privacy Policy. For more information on our use of Third-Party payment processors and financing partners, including the name(s) of the entities that we partner with, please email info@blissen.co.

4. ONWARD TRANSFER—BLISSEN MAY DISCLOSE YOUR INFORMATION

4.1 INFORMATION WE SHARE

We may share your information as described in this Privacy Policy (e.g., with our third party service providers; to comply with legal obligations; to enhance the Services, to protect and defend our rights and property) or with your permission.

We Use Vendors and Service Providers. We may share any information we receive with vendors and service providers. The types of service providers to whom we entrust Personal Information include service providers for: (i) provision of IT, analytics and related services; (ii) provision of information and services you have requested; (iii) payment processing; (iv) customer service activities such as member support; and (v) in connection with the provision of the Services. Blissen's policy is to execute appropriate contracts with the service providers that prohibit them from using or sharing Personal Information except as necessary to perform the contracted services on our behalf or to comply with applicable legal requirements, and this Privacy Policy.

Business Partners. Blissen may share Personal Information with our business partners and affiliates for our and our affiliates' internal business purposes or to provide you with a product or service that you have requested. Blissen may also provide Personal Information to business partners with whom we may jointly offer products or services, or whose products or services we believe may be of interest to you. In such cases, our business partner's name will appear, along with Blissen.

Displaying to Other Users. The content you post to the Services may be displayed on the Services. Other users of the Services may be able to see some information about you, such as your name if you submit a review or provide a testimonial to our Site. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of the other users who view and use posted information.

Marketing – Interest-Based Advertising and Third-Party Marketing. Blissen may allow third party advertising partners to set tracking tools (e.g., cookies) to collect information regarding your activities on our Sites (e.g., your IP address, page(s) visited, time of day). We may also share such de-identified information as well as selected Personal Information (such as demographic information and past purchase history) we have collected with third party advertising partners. These advertising partners may use this information (and similar information collected from other companies) for purposes of delivering targeted advertisements to you when you visit non-Blissen related websites within their networks. This practice is commonly referred to as "interest-based advertising" or "online behavioral advertising". We may allow access to other data collected by the Site to facilitate transmittal of information that may be useful, relevant, valuable or otherwise of interest to you. If you prefer that we do not share your Personal Information with third party advertising partners, you may opt-out of such sharing at no cost by following the instructions in Section 5 below.

Disclosures to Protect Us or Others (e.g., as Required by Law and Similar Disclosures). We may access, preserve and disclose your Personal Information, other account information and content if we believe doing so is required or appropriate: (i) to comply with law enforcement or national security requests and legal process, such as, a court order or subpoena; (ii) to respond to your requests; (iii) to protect yours, ours or others' rights, property or safety; (iv) to enforce Blissen policies or contracts; (v) to collect amounts owed to Blissen; (vi) to comply with records retention policies; (vii) when we believe access, preservation, or disclosure is necessary or appropriate to prevent physical harm or financial loss or in connection with an investigation or prosecution of suspected or actual illegal activity; or (viii) if we, in good faith, believe that access, preservation, or disclosure is otherwise necessary or advisable.

In addition, from time to time, server logs may be reviewed for security purposes – e.g., to detect unauthorized activity on the Services. In such cases, server log data containing IP addresses may be shared with law enforcement bodies in order to allow them to identify users in connection with their investigation of the unauthorized activities.

Merger, Sale, or Other Asset Transfers. If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, financing, reorganization, bankruptcy, receivership, sale of company assets or transition of service to another provider, then your information may be sold or transferred as part of such a transaction as permitted by law and/or contract. In such event, Blissen will endeavor to direct the transferee to use Personal Information in a manner that is consistent with the Privacy Policy in effect at the time such Personal Information was collected.

4.2 INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS

You agree that all Personal Information collected via or by Blissen may be transferred, Processed and stored anywhere in the world, including but not limited to, the United States, Canada, the European Union, in the cloud, on our servers, on the servers of our affiliates or on the servers of our service providers. Your Personal Information may be accessible to law enforcement or other authorities as described above. By providing information to Blissen, you explicitly consent to the storage of your Personal Information in these locations.

5. OPT-OUT (RIGHT TO OBJECT TO PROCESSING)

5.1 GENERAL

You have the right to object to and opt-out of certain uses and disclosures of your Personal Information. Where you have consented to Blissen's Processing of your Personal Information or Sensitive Personal Information, you may withdraw that consent at any time and opt-out to further Processing by contacting info@blissen.co. Even if you opt-out, we may still collect and use non-Personal Information regarding your activities on our Service and/or information from the advertisements on third party websites for non-interest based advertising purposes, such as, to determine the effectiveness of the advertisements.

5.2 EMAIL, TEXT AND TELEPHONE COMMUNICATIONS

You can unsubscribe from email, text and phone communications at any time. To stop receiving our promotional emails, follow the unsubscribe instructions in the email messages you receive from us or contact us as described in Section 11. We will process your request within a reasonable time after receipt, in accordance with applicable laws. Note that you will continue to receive transaction-related emails regarding products or services you have requested. We may also send you certain non-promotional communications regarding Blissen and our Services and, to the extent permitted by law, you will not be able to opt-out of those communications (e.g., communications regarding updates to our Terms or this Privacy Policy).

5.3 MOBILE DEVICES

In the future, Blissen may occasionally send you push notifications through our Apps with updates, achievements and other notices that may be of interest to you. You may at any time opt-out from receiving these types of communications by changing the settings on your device.

5.4 "DO NOT TRACK"

Do Not Track ("DNT") is a privacy preference that users can set in certain web browsers. DNT is a way for users to inform websites and services that they do not want certain information about their webpage visits collected over time and across websites or online services. Please note

that we do not respond to or honor DNT signals or similar mechanisms transmitted by web browsers.

5.5 COOKIES AND INTEREST-BASED ADVERTISING

As noted above, you may stop or restrict the placement of cookies on your computer or remove them from your browser by adjusting your web browser preferences. Please note that cookie-based opt-outs are not effective on mobile applications. However, on many mobile devices, application users may opt-out of certain mobile advertisements via their device settings.

The online advertising industry also provides websites from which you may opt-out of receiving targeted ads from our data partners and our other advertising partners that participate in self-regulatory programs. You can access these, and also learn more about targeted advertising and consumer choice and privacy, at www.networkadvertising.org/managing/opt_out.asp, www.youronlinechoices.eu/ or www.youradchoices.ca/, and www.aboutads.info/choices/. You can also choose not to be included in Google Analytics here.

To be clear, whether you are using our opt-out or an online industry opt-out, these cookie-based opt-outs must be performed on each device and browser that you wish to have opted-out. For example, if you have opted-out on your computer browser, that opt-out will not be effective on your mobile device. You must separately opt-out on each device. Advertisements on third party websites that contain the AdChoices link, and that link to this Privacy Policy, may have been directed to you based on anonymous, non-Personal Information collected by advertising partners over time and across websites.
